Coverage summary	
Eligibility	Enrolled as an international student in the School Board International Student Health Plan, with a valid Study Permit, attending full-time classes and not eligible for coverage under any provincial or territorial health insurance plan.
Pre-existing condition exclusion	Benefits are not payable for covered expenses caused by or resulting from any illness or injury or medical condition where signs or symptoms appeared or required medical attention or consultation, hospitalization or treatment (including changes in medication or dosage) during the 90-day period before coverage began.
Eligible medical expenses	For benefits covered in this policy, you are covered for the <i>medical treatment</i> of an illness or injury sustained while insured under this plan.
Maximum liability	\$3 million in the coverage period

Hospitalization	In-patient and Out-patient hospital charges
Diagnostic services	Diagnostic, laboratory tests and/or x-rays when medically necessary
Ambulance services	Ground and air ambulance to the nearest hospital
Medical Equipment & Miscellaneous Medical	Covered when prescribed by the attending physician, such as crutches, casts, temporary rental of wheelchair etc.
Emergency out of Canada	Up to 30-day trips, no coverage in home country
Private duty nurse	\$2,000 in the coverage period
 Immunization & vaccination 	\$150 in the coverage period
 Testing & vaccination for tuberculosis 	\$100 in the coverage period with purchase of 12 month period
